What is a museum?



A MUSEUM is a special place that stores and protects collections of important objects.

Museums make these items available for people to view through exhibits where you can see and sometimes touch real objects on display.

- Help learners develop 21st century skills such as critical thinking, communication, creativity and collaboration
- Offer learners the chance to connect with scientists and other experts

























Why is object-based learning so powerful?
